

**RESOLUTION NO. 2019 - 138**

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**A RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING EARLY TERMINATION OF THE BUSINESS LICENSING ADMINISTRATION CONTRACT AND REINSTATEMENT OF SAID SERVICES IN-HOUSE TO BE PERFORMED BY CITY PERSONNEL; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

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**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs (“City”) previously outsourced business license administration for a one-year term, with up to two one-year automatic renewals unless the City gave notice of non-renewal thirty days prior to the beginning of the new term;


**WHEREAS**, the City identified certain contract performance issues three months into the first renewal term and considered providing a notice of possible termination;


**WHEREAS**, given the limitations associated with termination once into a renewal term, the City requested the vendor to consider a voluntary early contract termination prior to the 2020 business license renewal period, and the vendor voluntarily agreed to early termination;

**WHEREAS**, the City desires to formally recognize the voluntary early contract termination;


**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it formally recognizes the voluntary early termination of the outside vendor contract providing business license administration services and the reinstatement of said services in-house to be administered by city personnel. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.

**SO RESOLVED** this 21<sup>st</sup> day of October, 2019.




