

RESOLUTION 2022 - 016


A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH CALIFORNIA SKATEPARKS TO COMPLETE A SKATEPARK WITHIN THE SILVER COMET LINEAR PARK UNDER THE 2016 SPECIAL PURPOSE LOCAL OPTION SALES TAX PROGRAM; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS, the 2016 Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (SPLOST) program included recreational and park improvements, including improvements at Silver Comet Linear Park and the removal and relocation of the existing climbing structure; and

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") solicited and obtained bids to complete said improvements, and the City desires to accept the recommendation of its SPLOST Program Manager, Croy Engineering, LLC ("Croy") to award the contract to California Skateparks as the qualified design build company.


BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with California Skateparks to design and construct a skatepark, including removal and relocation of the existing climbing structure, within the Silver Comet Linear Park under the SPLOST program, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.






