A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF COMMUNITY AFFAIRS SERVICE DELIVERY STRATEGY FORM CERTIFYING THE EXISTING SERVICE DELIVERY STRATEGY WITH COBB COUNTY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (the "City") and Cobb County (the "County") have both prepared major updates to their respective Comprehensive Plans triggering application of O.C.G.A. 30-70-28, which requires re-certification of the existing County Service Delivery Strategy (the "SDS");

WHEREAS, the three elements of the SDS are the Millage Intergovernmental Agreement, the Land Use Intergovernmental Agreement and the Amendment to the Land Use Intergovernmental Agreement, which was approved in 2014 and is effective for ten years;

WHEREAS, the re-certification does not extend the agreement beyond 2014 but is required as an acknowledgement that the SDS continues to reflect the preferred arrangements for providing local services, and the City has no changes to the SDS at this time;

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves the Georgia Department of Community Affairs Service Deliver Strategy, Form 5, Extension of Existing SDS and authorizes the Mayor to execute said form after review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
