A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE 6TH AMENDMENT TO THE ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH CROY ENGINEERING, LLC IN THE AMOUNT OF \$22,425.00 TO PERFORM CONSTRUCTION INSPECTION SERVICES FOR STORMWATER REPAIRS AT CERTAIN LOCATIONS WITHIN THE CITY OF POWDER SPRINGS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS, the City and Croy Engineering, LLC entered into the Professional Services Agreement for Engineering Services dated as of February 14, 2020; and


WHEREAS, the City has identified capital repairs needed to stormwater infrastructure at 3479 Hollow Stream Trail, 3290 Country Walk Drive, 3121 Nectar Drive, and 3510 Ten Oaks Court and allocated funds from its American Rescue Plan Act grant for this purpose and has awarded a contract to S.H. Creel Contracting to complete these needed capital repairs; and


WHEREAS, Croy Engineering, LLC has the expertise and capacity to perform necessary construction inspection services for this repair contract to ensure the contractor's work performance is of high quality and to protect the interests of the City and its taxpayers;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute the 6th Amendment to the Professional Services Agreement for Engineering Services with Croy Engineering, LLC in the amount not to exceed \$22,425.00 to provide construction inspection services for contracted stormwater repairs, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.




