A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE ATLANTA REGIONAL COMMISSION TO PARTICIPATE IN AND ACCEPT FUNDS THROUGH THE LIVABLE CENTERS INITIATIVE PROGRAM TO PREPARE A NEW AND UPDATED LCI PLAN; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs previously applied for and was selected to receive funds through the Atlanta Regional Commission's Livable Centers Initiative (LCI) program for a total program cost of \$200,000 with \$160,000 provided through the LCI and the remaining \$40,000 provided as a local match;

WHEREAS the award will enable the city to prepare a new and updated LCI Plan to keep the previous plan relevant and produce new recommendations for implementation, particularly in light of the substantial growth and development that have taken place; and

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs desires to enter into an agreement with the Atlanta Regional Commission to accept said funds and to participate in the LCI program to complete a new plan.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the mayor to execute an agreement with the Atlanta Regional Commission to participate in the LCI program, subject to review and approval by the city attorney.
