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**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH COMCAST FOR TECHNOLOGICAL IMPROVEMENTS AT THE OLD MUSEUM LOCATION IN POWDER SPRINGS PARK; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**


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**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs (the "City") owns property at the Powder Springs Park previously occupied by the Seven Springs Museum, which will be used by the Parks and Recreation Department and as office incubator space; and


**WHEREAS**, said uses require certain technical improvements to enable communication and internet access, and the City desires to accept the proposal by Comcast to complete the necessary improvements;


