A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH Tunnell-Spangler& Associates d/b/a TSW TO STUDY DIFFERENT DOWNTOWN LOCATIONS FOR TRASH COLLECTION AND GREASE STORAGE GENERATED BY DOWNTOWN BUSINESSES FOR A SUM NOT TO EXCEED \$4500; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") previously located a dumpster in the downtown to serve certain downtown restaurant businesses that must be relocated in order for the downtown redevelopment project to proceed;

WHEREAS, the City desires to work with its Livable Centers Initiative consultant, Tunnel Spangler & Associates d/b/a TSW ("TSW") to identify an appropriate location for the trash collection and grease storage for certain downtown businesses, and TSW is willing and available to assist in such effort for a sum not to exceed \$4500;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and authorizes the Mayor to execute a contract with TSW to work with the City to identify a location for trash collection and grease storage for certain downtown businesses for a sum not to exceed \$4,500, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
