A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE COBB COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AGREEMENT FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2021; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID AMENDMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs' (the "City") previously approved the Cobb County Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Subrecipient Agreement for Program Year 2021, CD21-C21C8 ("2021 CDBG Agreement"), improvements at the Senior Center and Hopkins Road for an amount of \$85,723.83; and
