

RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 097

**A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND APPROVING AN AMENDMENT TO THE COBB COUNTY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT AGREEMENT FOR PROGRAM YEAR 2021; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE SAID AMENDMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs' (the "City") previously approved the Cobb County Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") Subrecipient Agreement for Program Year 2021, CD21-C21C8 ("2021 CDBG Agreement"), improvements at the Senior Center and Hopkins Road for an amount of \$85,723.83; and

**WHEREAS**, the CDBG program office presented the City an amendment to increase the approved amount for the 2021 CDBG Agreement to \$86,987.04 ("Amendment 2") and requires submittal of the executed amendment by June 25, 2021;


**NOW THEREFORE**, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and approves Amendment 2 to the 2021 CDBG Agreement to increase the program year 2021 dollars to \$86,987.04. This Resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
