A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH THE UNITED STATES IMMIGRATION AND CUSTOMS ENFORCEMENT HOMELAND SECURITY INVESTIGATIONS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS, the Secretary of Homeland Security is authorized to designate certain persons to perform certain duties of a Customers Officer conducting Homeland Security Investigations (“HSI”);


WHEREAS, there may be instances when United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement HIS determines that it is desirable for certain sworn law enforcement employees of the City of Powder Springs (“City”) to perform certain HIS duties pursuant to the terms of a Memorandum of Understanding;


WHEREAS, the City finds it in the interest of public health, safety and welfare to enter into an MOU setting forth the roles and responsibilities between the parties;

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with the United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement Homeland Security Investigations setting forth the terms and relationship between the parties, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.




