
A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION RELATING TO MAINTENANCE BY THE CITY OF CERTAIN SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS INSTALLED BY THE DEPARTMENT AT AND NEAR THE FINCH ROAD RAILROAD CROSSING; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the Georgia Department of Transportation ("GDOT") intends to design and install certain safety improvements at its expense at and near the railway crossing at Finch Road as shown in the attached "Exhibit A"; and


WHEREAS in exchange for the design and installation of the improvements, the GDOT has notified the City of Powder Springs of the responsibility of the City to maintain said improvements at an approximate annual cost of \$1000, and the City finds it in the public interest to accept and maintain the safety improvements and authorize the Mayor to execute an agreement with GDOT setting forth the responsibilities of the parties.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with the GDOT relating to safety improvements at the railway crossing on Finch Road, in form substantially similar to the attached Exhibit "B" and subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.




