

RESOLUTION 2022 - 146

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SURPLUSING AND DISPOSAL OF 60 TASER CARTRIDGES AND 18 BATTERIES HELD BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT WHICH ARE NO LONGER NEEDED AND TRANSFER SAME TO THE CITY OF HIRAM POLICE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs Police Department is in possession of sixty taser cartridges and eighteen batteries which are incompatible with the newly replaced tasers; and


WHEREAS Georgia Code 36-37-6(D) authorizes the City to dispose of personal property by selling or transferring the property to another governing authority for public purposes without competitive bid or auction; and


WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs previously authorized the transfer of said equipment to the Oglethorpe County Sheriff's Department by Resolution 2021-198, but because the Oglethorpe County Sheriff's Department no longer desires to receive the equipment, the City's Police Department requests approval to transfer the equipment to the City of Hiram police department;


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it declares as surplus the sixty taser cartridges and eighteen batteries held by the Police Department which are not compatible with and no longer needed for such purposes and authorizes the transfer of said cartridges to the City of Hiram Police Department. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.






