**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH WORKSOURCE COBB TO PROVIDE WORK BASED LEARNING SERVICES WHICH PRESENT AN OPPORTUNITY TO IMPROVE JOB AND CAREER OPTIONS; TO PROVIDE FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**


**WHEREAS** the City of Powder Springs (“the City”) is eligible to participate in the program offered by WorkSource Cobb (“WSC”) to provide work-based learning services for City employees that improve job and career options; and


**WHEREAS** WSC will consider funding for the City’s CDL training program and interpretive certification program upon application to the program and successful completion of the training; and


**WHEREAS** the City desires to apply to the program and enter into an agreement for funding assistance to offset costs of its professional and career development initiatives for CDL training and interpretive certification.






