
A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH IRONSCALES INC. FOR SOFTWARE LICENSING TO PROVIDE GREATER SECURITY FROM EMAIL PHISHING ATTACKS; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs utilizes various software programs to support and enhance municipal operations, but none provides cloud-based email security platform to defend against phishing email attacks; and


WHEREAS the City has suffered recent phishing email attacks which compromise the integrity of city and customer data, and the City therefore swiftly acted to obtain licensing for email security, and the City desires to ratify said emergency action and to approve and authorize an annual license for 70 users to better guard against email phishing attacks.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the emergency subscription of email security software is ratified and the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement with Ironscales Inc. for the annual subscription for 70 licensed products at a cost of \$2,940.00, with the fee increasing by 10% at renewal, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.






