A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING WITH LEXISNEXIS COPLOGIC SOLUTIONS, INC. TO CLARIFY TERMS OF A REVENUE SHARING ARRANGEMENT FOR ONLINE SALE OF CRASH REPORTS PREPARED BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, LexisNexis Coplogic Solutions, Inc. ("Coplogic") has a contractual relationship with the Georgia Department of Transportation through which it provides the Georgia Electronic Accident Reporting System (GEARS) to law enforcement agencies at no cost in order for the law enforcement agencies to submit crash information to the GDOT GEARS repository; and

WHEREAS, Coplogic provides for online distribution of automobile accident reports and shares the revenue from sales of such reports with the submitting law enforcement agency; and

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("the City") has an existing revenue sharing arrangement with Coplogic or one of its predecessors through which the Police Department submits automobile accident reports; and

WHEREAS, Coplogic has prepared and presented to the City a Memorandum of Understanding in order to clarify the terms of the revenue sharing arrangement with regard to the re-sale of automobile accident reports; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council wish to enter into such Memorandum of Understanding.

**NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute a Memorandum of Understanding with LexisNexis Coplogic Solutions, Inc., after review and approval by the City Attorney. This Resolution shall be effective upon adoption.
