

RESOLUTION 2022 - 004

A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE PURCHASE OF FOUR LIDAR SPEED DETECTION DEVICES FOR THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs Police Department utilizes speed detection camera devices with lidar/laser technology to enforce speed limits within the City; and

WHEREAS, there are currently six (6) such devices in use, three (3) of which are nineteen (19) to twenty (20) years old, and three of which are five (5) years old; and

WHEREAS, the average lifespan of a lidar camera is seven (7) to ten (10) years; and the use of older devices is susceptible to being challenged in terms of accuracy and reliability; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department can purchase four new devices for a total of \$6000.00; and


WHEREAS, updating such equipment and replacing aging and obsolete equipment will serve the health, safety and welfare of the citizens of the City of Powder Springs by ensuring accurate speed limit enforcement.






