GENERAL EDUCATIONAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM

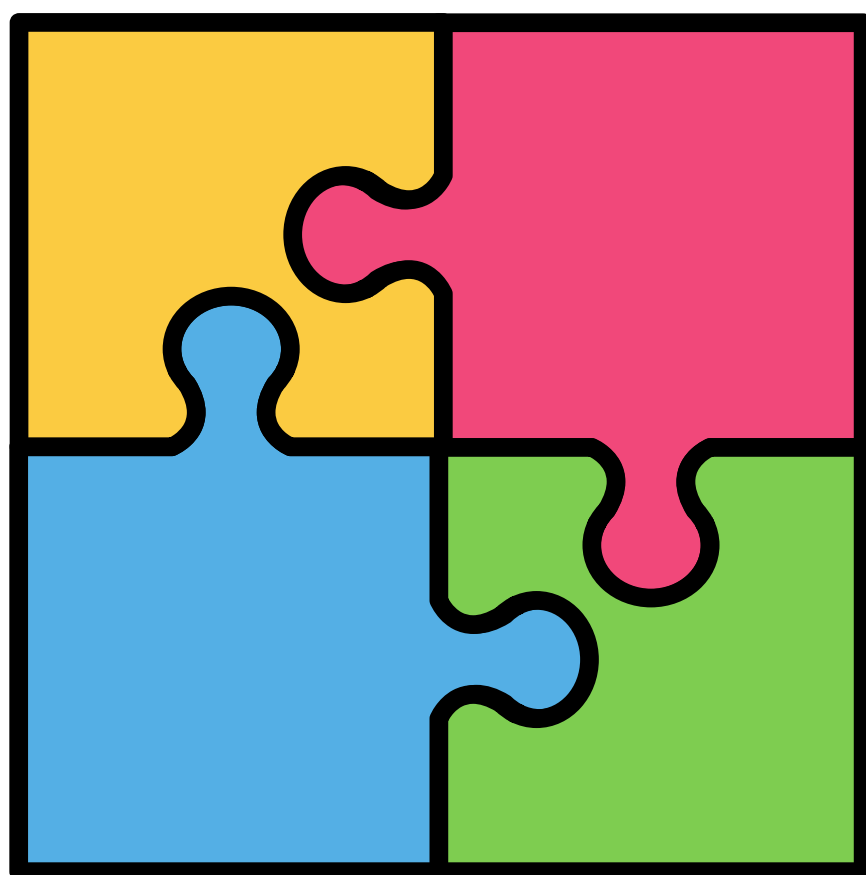

The test shows you have the same knowledge and skills as someone who completed high school in the United States. When you pass, you get a certificate that offers you the same opportunities as a high school diploma.

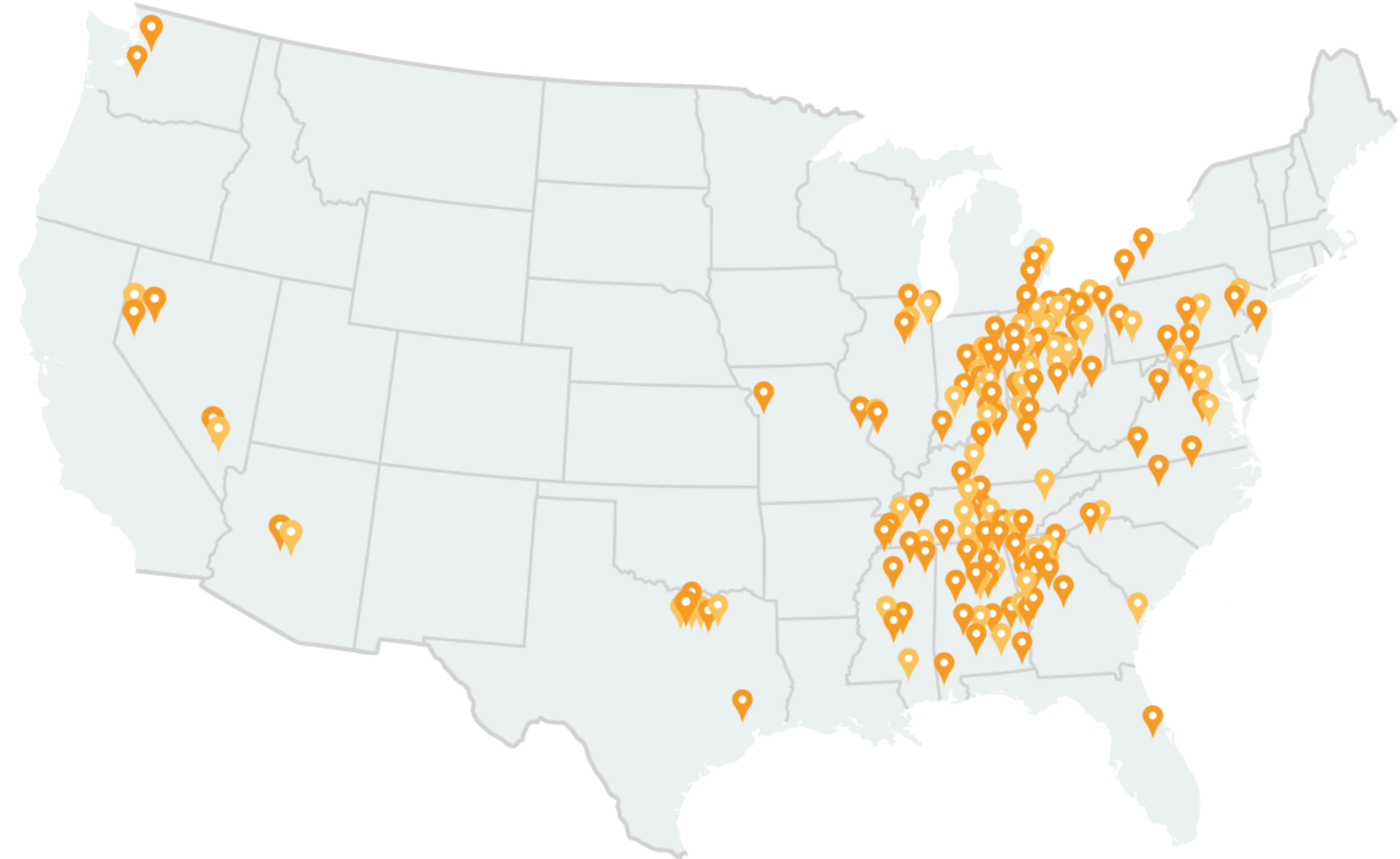

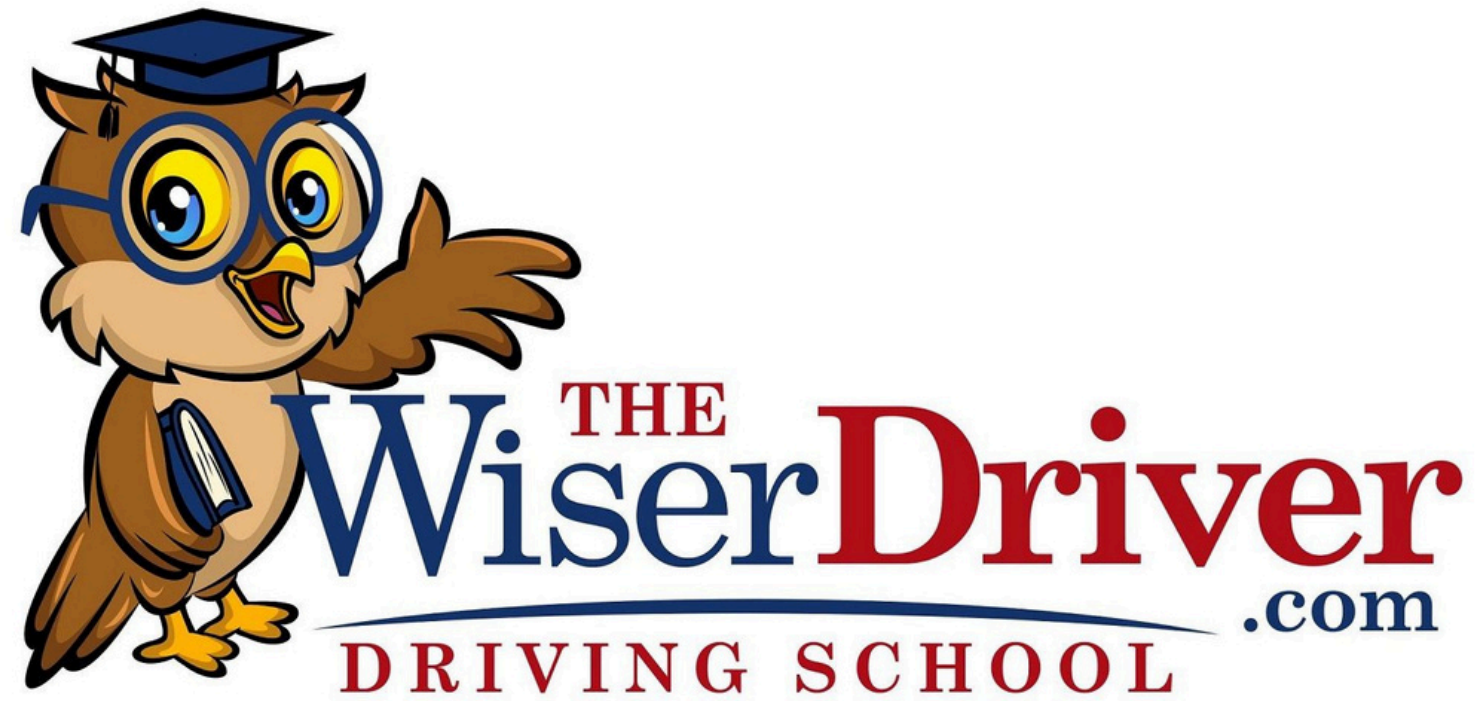

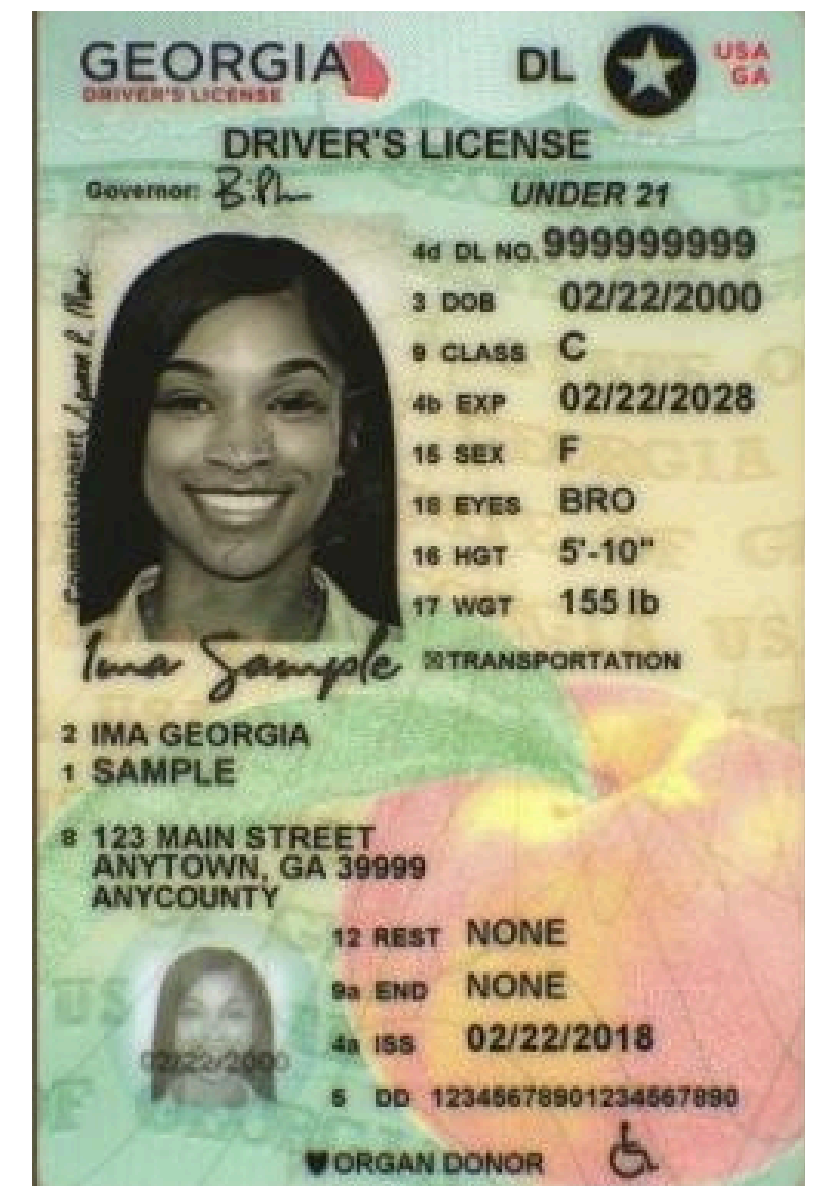
STAFFING

There will be a graduation ceremony every 4 months. The first course of classes will be offered from August through November. Graduation for that course will be at the beginning of December.

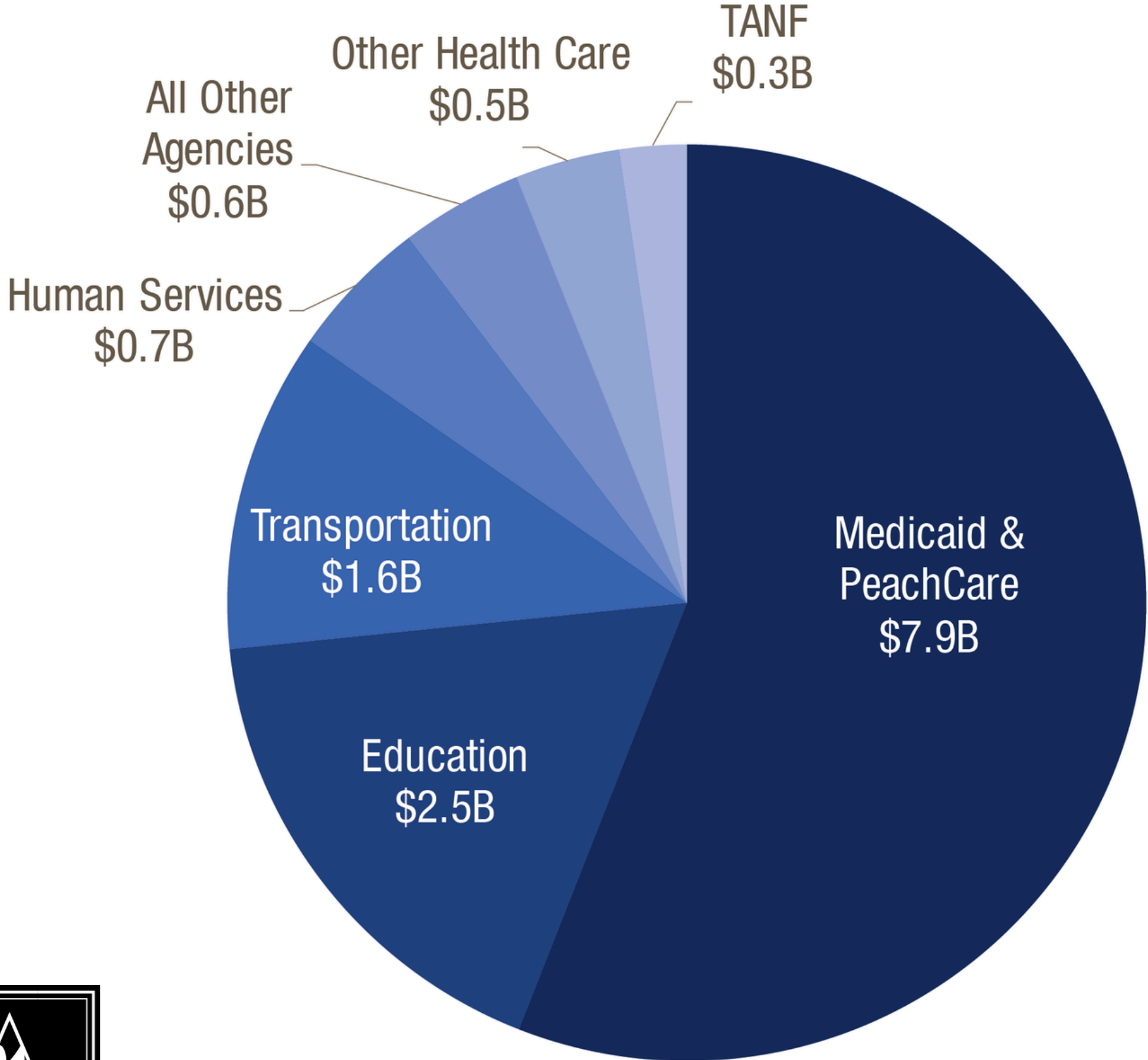
The second course of classes will be offered in January and will end in April. Graduation for that course will be held in May of each year.
