

RESOLUTION 2026 - 091

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE FINANCE DIRECTOR OR HIS OR HER DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE A RENEWAL AGREEMENT WITH THE GEORGIA CRIME INFORMATION CENTER (GCIC) TO ACCESS BACKGROUND INFORMATION RELATING TO APPLICANTS FOR ALCOHOL LICENSES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") alcohol beverage ordinance requires background checks of applicants for alcohol licenses; and

WHEREAS the licensing authority is required to have its own Originating Agency Identifier ("ORI") number to conduct a federal background check, and the City previously approved an agreement to enable licensing to obtain its ORI to conduct the required background check of alcohol license applicants; and


WHEREAS the current agreement authorizing access to said information is subject to renewal, and the City desires to authorize the Finance Director or his or her designee and Mayor to execute an agreement with GCIC to access information needed to conduct a background check.

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor and Finance Director or his or her designee are authorized to execute an agreement with the Georgia Crime Information Center for the purposes of conducting the required background check of alcohol license applicants.


