A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A RADIO SYSTEM USER LICENSE AGREEMENT WITH COBB COUNTY; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Cobb County is the owner and operator of an 800 MHz radio system, and the City of Powder Springs is a present user on the System ("System"), furthering the goal of protecting the health, safety, and welfare of its citizens and assisting Cobb County and other system users in emergency situations; and

WHEREAS, the City entered into the Original "800 MHz Radio System User License Agreement" with the County, dated September 21, 1998, a "Second 800 MHz Radio System User License Agreement" with an effective date of October 1, 2005 and an "Amended and Restated License Agreement September 21, 2015", which allowed the City to use a certain number of subscriber units on the County's system and set forth the terms and conditions of such license (collectively, the "Agreement"); and

WHEREAS, as a result of regular system upgrades consistent with technological advances, Cobb County has offered amendments to the Agreement for a unified system that accounts for said upgrades, and the City desires to continue to license subscriber units on the County System, subject to terms and conditions of a new license agreement that will supersede and replace the current agreement;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute a Radio License Agreement with Cobb County in form substantially similar to the attached and subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval.
