

## RESOLUTION 2017-079

**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PURCHASE AND EQUIP A POLICE VEHICLE FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$37,000; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS REQUIRED TO COMPLETE THE TRANSACTIONS; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs ("City") has an established vehicle take-home policy for the City's police officers;

**WHEREAS**, the Fiscal Year 2018 budget includes funds for the purchase of a police vehicle, and the City desires to authorize the Police Department to purchase and equip a vehicle using said funds;

**BE IT THEREFOR RESOLVED** by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that the Police Department is authorized to purchase from Brannen Ford and equip using ProLogicITS one vehicle for an amount not to exceed \$37,000.00.00;


**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Mayor is authorized to execute agreements required to complete said transactions, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution is effective immediately upon adoption.




