

RESOLUTION 2023 - 121

**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH THE CITY OF SMYRNA RELATING TO THE HOUSING OF INMATES IN THE SMYRNA JAIL; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS** the City of Powder Springs (the "City") previously approved an agreement with the City of Smyrna relating to the housing, bonding and GDIC data entry; and

**WHEREAS** with rising costs and staffing shortages, the terms and conditions of said agreement are no longer feasible, and both Cities desire to execute a new intergovernmental agreement governing housing only. and

**WHEREAS** required bonding will be performed by City municipal court and public safety personnel.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the Mayor to execute an intergovernmental agreement with city of Smyrna relating to the housing of inmates at Smyrna's jail, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
