

RESOLUTION 2023 - 185


A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH COBB COUNTY RELATING TO THE UPGRADE, FUNDING, OPERATION AND MAINTENANCE OF TRAFFIC SIGNALS AT CERTAIN LOCATIONS WITHIN THE CITY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs previously approved an Intergovernmental Agreement with Cobb County to upgrade and improve traffic signals at three intersections in the City on Marietta Street at Brownsville Road, New Macland Road and Austell Powder Spring Road at a cost of \$900,000 (the "Agreement") using the 2022 Special Purpose Local Options Sales Tax program ("SPLOST"); and


WHEREAS bids were solicited by the County and the lowest responsive and responsible bid came in at a cost \$173,904.42 higher, and the City and County desire to amend the Agreement to approve the additional funds from the SPLOST program;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor is authorized to execute an amendment to the agreement with Cobb County to increase the funding for the signal upgrade from \$900,000 to \$1,073,904.42, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.
