A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE AND USE OF THURMAN SPRINGS PARK, MUNICIPAL PARKING, CITY TRAILS AND CITY ROADS TO ACCOMMODATE THE 5K AND ARTS FESTIVAL HOSTED BY THE SOUTH COBB ARTS ALLIANCE ON SEPTEMBER 13, 2025 FROM 7AM TO 8PM BEGINNING AND ENDING AT THURMAN SPRINGS PARK; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") has received a temporary special event application from the South Cobb Arts Alliance ("SCAA") to host a 5K and arts festival on the City's 5K certified route using city trails and streets and beginning and ending at Thurman Springs Park on September 13, 2025 from 7AM to 8PM; and

WHEREAS the City desires to accommodate the temporary event and allow the temporary closure and use of certain public spaces to further its strategic priorities of creating an atmosphere of community and creating destinations that appeal to residents and visitors.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the temporary closure and use of Thurman Springs Park, municipal parking, city trails and city streets adjacent to the race route on September 13, 2025 from 7am to 8pm for a 5K and arts festival event hosted by the South Cobb Arts Alliance, subject to the applicant providing security and traffic control as determined by the Chief of Police, providing for sanitation and clean up following the event as determined by the Public Work Sanitation Director and providing written notice of the event at least 30 days in advance of the event to the businesses located in the downtown, with said notice also provided to the Parks Department.
