A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT TO RENEW THE AGILITY DISASTER RECOVERY SERVICES MEMBERSHIP FOR A MONTHLY AMOUNT OF \$1121.18; TO UPGRADE THE MEMBERSHIP; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") has previously approved membership with Agility Disaster Recovery Services to obtain office space and equipment, power, communications and computer systems from Agility vendors for damage to certain facilities, which includes the public facilities on and adjacent to the town square and its remote facilities at Public Works and the Police Department in the event of a disaster;

WHEREAS, the upgrade will include for three locations satellite connectivity up to 350Mbps, with bandwidth on demand fees at use or cellular 4 or 5g connectivity services billed at \$15/gb with bandwidth speeds dependent on carrier; and

WHEREAS, the membership becomes the foundation of the City's Continuity of Operations Plan and enables the City to work with Agility to determine City needs and obtain the necessary infrastructure faster, cheaper and more effectively, and the City desires to renew and upgrade its membership with Agility;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it approves the renewal of the Agility Disaster Recovery Services membership for three one-year terms and authorizes the Mayor to execute a renewal agreement with Agility at a fee of \$1121.18 per month, with the increase waived for three months until January 2024. This resolution is effective upon adoption.
