

Resolution No. 2019-109

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED BY THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION TO COMPLETE THE LOCAL ADMINISTERED PROJECTS CERTIFICATION PROCESS IN ORDER TO RECEIVE FEDERAL TRANSPORTATION DOLLARS; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Georgia Department of Transportation (GDOT) has developed a Local Administered Projects (LAP) Certification process to ensure the resource capacity and ability of the Local Public Agency (Local Agency) to successfully manage, administer and execute the policies and procedures for Federal and State compliance in order to receive federal funding participation;

WHEREAS, The LAP Certification application is used to determine if Local Public Agencies will qualify to administer federal-aid projects and is required in order to apply for and receive federal transportation dollars;

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs desires to complete the LAP certification process and apply for and receive federal transportation funds;

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor is authorized to execute the necessary documentation required by the GDOT to receive the Local Administered Projects (LAP) certification in order to be qualified to receive federal transportation funds, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval.


