
A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH RIVER NORTH TRANSIT, LLC TO RENEW THE LEASE FOR EIGHT PARKING SPACES FOR THE STORAGE AND PARKING OF EIGHT COBBLINC GO VANS IN THE POLICE DEPARTMENT PARKING LOT; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") previously approved and authorized the Mayor to execute an agreement with River North Transit, LLC as operator of the micro transit program within Cobb County to lease eight parking spaces at the City's police department in order to facilitate transportation services to its residents; and


WHEREAS the lessor desires to renew the lease agreement for another twelve-month term and has agreed to a three percent rental increase, and the City finds it in the public interest to renew said agreement and authorize the rental of parking spaces on public property for the micro transit program.

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with River North Transit, LLC to renew the rental of eight parking spaces in the city's police department parking lot for the parking and storage of eight Cobb Linc Micro Transit Go vans, subject to a monthly rental fee and continued maintenance of liability insurance. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.


