A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE SURPLUS AND DISPOSAL OF TWO PRISONER CAGES, TWO LAPTOP STANDS AND ONE RADAR UNIT WHICH ARE NO LONGER NEEDED BY THE CTY OF POWDER SPRINGS POLICE DEPARTMENT AND TRANSFER SAME TO THE CITY OF ARAGON POLICE DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs Police Department is in possession of two prisoner cages for vehicles, two laptop stands and one radar unit which are no longer needed;

WHEREAS Georgia Code 36-37-6(D) authorizes the City to dispose of personal property by selling or transferring the property to another governing authority for public purposes without competitive bid or auction; and

WHEREAS the City's Police Chief requests and recommends the transfer of said equipment to the City of Aragon Police Department, and the City desires to accept and approve the recommendation and request.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it declares as surplus the two prisoner cages for vehicles, two laptop stands and one radar unit held by the Police Department which are no longer needed for its operations and authorizes the transfer of said items to the City of Aragon Police Department. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
