A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION DIVISION TO RECEIVE ADDITIONAL FUNDING ASSISTANCE FOR RECYCLING DROP-OFF FACILITY LOCATED AT THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the Georgia Department of Natural Resources ("DNR") administers a grant program under the Georgia Solid Waste Management Act to reduce solid waste in Georgia and recover valuable materials through recycling, waste reduction and/or diversion; and

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs ("City") applied for and received a Recycling, Waste Reduction and Diversion grant to establish a multi-stream recycling drop-off center within the City; and

WHEREAS the City requested and was granted approval to received additional grant dollars to offset additional costs related to the recycling drop off center, and it desires to execute an amendment to the agreement with DNR to receive said funds.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor is authorized to execute an amendment to the agreement with the Georgia Department of Natural Resources Environmental Protection Division, in form substantially similar to the attached, to accept and implement additional grant funds for the recycling drop-off center in the City, subject to review and approval by the City attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval.
