A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH KNINE ALLSYSTEMS TO INSTALL A CONVERGED ACCESS CONTROL SYTSEM AND INTRUSION SYSTEM AT THE AMPHITHEATER IN THURMAN SPRINGS PARK FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$4,238; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation department has examined alternatives for securing the green room at the Hardy Family Automotive Amphitheater (the "Amphitheater") after hours and recommends the installation of a converged access control system and intrusion system that would secure the facility and prevent unscheduled access;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the installation of a converged access control system and intrusion system at the Amphitheater in Thurman Springs Park, and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Knine AllSystems for an amount of \$2825.60 for access control and \$1412.40 for intrusion for a total cost of \$4238.00, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
