

RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 089


**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH KNINE ALLSYSTEMS TO INSTALL A CONVERGED ACCESS CONTROL SYTSEM AND INTRUSION SYSTEM AT THE AMPHITHEATER IN THURMAN SPRINGS PARK FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$4,238; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

WHEREAS, the Parks and Recreation department has examined alternatives for securing the green room at the Hardy Family Automotive Amphitheater (the "Amphitheater") after hours and recommends the installation of a converged access control system and intrusion system that would secure the facility and prevent unscheduled access;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the installation of a converged access control system and intrusion system at the Amphitheater in Thurman Springs Park, and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Knine AllSystems for an amount of \$2825.60 for access control and \$1412.40 for intrusion for a total cost of \$4238.00, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
