A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE THE ANNUAL COMMUNITY RATING SYSTEM RECERTIFICATION FORM; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the National Flood Insurance Program (NFIP) Community Rating System (CRS) was implemented to recognize and encourage community floodplain management activities exceeding minimum standards;


WHEREAS, under the CRS, flood insurance premium rates are discounted to reward actions that meet the CRS goals of reducing flood damage to insurable property, strengthen and support the insurance aspects of the NFIP and encourage a comprehensive approach to floodplain management;


WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs participates in the Community Rating System and has met the Class 6 prerequisite with a Building Code Effectiveness Classification of 4/4;


WHEREAS, each year CRS communities must verify continued performance of activities that are credited by the CRS and submit an annual recertification application;


