A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH RCS PROMOTIONS TO DEVELOP AND HOST THE ANNUAL CONCERT SERIES IN THE DOWNTOWN PARK; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("the City") previously solicited, received, and accepted a proposal from RCS Promotions to plan and execute an annual concert series at the Downtown Park, which was memorialized in a formal agreement; and

WHEREAS, the COVID-19 pandemic created a declared public health state of emergency necessitating a cancellation of the originally scheduled event dates; and

WHEREAS, the City and RCS wish to amend their agreement in order to move the scheduled event dates from 2020 to 2021 at no additional cost to the City.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves an amendment to the agreement with RCS Promotions in order to move the subject concert series event dates from 2020 to 2021 and to otherwise clarify the rights and responsibilities of the parties and authorizes the Mayor to execute such amendment after review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
