

RESOLUTION 2023 - 062


A RESOLUTION CONDITIONALLY APPROVING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE AND USE OF A PORTION OF THE MUNICIPAL PARKING FRONTING MARIETTA STREET FOR TEMPORARY SPECIAL EVENTS ON THE FIRST AND THIRD THURSDAY OF EACH MONTH BETWEEN APRIL 2023 AND OCTOBER 2023 DURING THE HOURS OF 4:00PM and 9:00PM TO ACCOMMODATE THE DOWNTOWN MARKET CONDUCTED BY THE DOWNTOWN BUSINESSES; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs (“City”) has received a temporary special event application from Special Blends Bartending on behalf of downtown businesses to conduct the 2023 Downtown Market on the 1st and 3rd Thursday of each month between April 2023 and October 2023 from 4:00PM and 9:00PM, as described in the attached “Exhibit A”, in the front half of the municipal parking lot owned by the City that fronts Marietta Street, as shown on the attached Exhibit “B”; and


WHEREAS the City desires to accommodate the temporary event and allow the temporary closure and use of a portion of the municipal parking lot for the 2023 Downtown Market as described in the attached exhibits and in support of creating destinations that facilitate economic development and tourism, subject to the written notification to and acknowledgement by downtown businesses fronting Marietta Street and Broad Street of the events dates and parking restrictions, compliance with safety and traffic guidelines issues by the Chief of Police, post-event cleanup of the entire municipal parking lot by the applicants, and submittal of the written notice and acknowledgement to the City Parks Department in advance of the first scheduled event.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the temporary closure and use of a portion of the municipal parking lot fronting Marietta Street to conduct the Downtown Market on the first and third Thursday of each month between April 2023 and October 2023 during the hours of 4:00PM and 9:00PM as described in the attached Exhibits “A” and “B”, subject to the applicant providing security and traffic control as determined by the Chief of Police, providing for sanitation and cleanup of the entire parking lot following the event, providing written notice to and acknowledgement by the businesses fronting Marietta Street and Broad Street, and submittal of the written notices and acknowledgements to the City Parks Department a week in advance of the first scheduled event. This resolution is effective immediately upon approval.


