**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE PERMIT DOCUMENTS ISSUED BY THE GEORGIA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION FOR IMPROVEMENTS ON BROWNSVILLE ROAD AT ITS INTERSECTION WITH STATE ROUTE 278 AT CH JAMES PARKWAY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs has previously approved improvements on Brownsville Road at its intersection with State Route 278 (“CH James Parkway”);

**WHEREAS**, said improvements are programmed for construction under the Special Purpose Local Options Sales Tax program and are located in part within the public right of way owned by the State of Georgia;

**WHEREAS**, the State of Georgia requires certain agreements in order to construct within the right of way;


