A RESOLUTION ACCEPTING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A CONSERVATION EASEMENT GRANTED BY VILLAS OF SEVEN SPRINGS WEST CONDOMINIUMS FOR THE PROTECTION OF A STREAM BUFFER; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Seven Springs Development is currently constructing residential dwellings on lots within Villas of Seven Springs West, which contain a stream considered state waters that are required to be buffered;


WHEREAS, Seven Springs Development desires to grant and the City of Powder Springs desires to accept a conservation easement for said lots;




