A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH NATIONAL SIGN PLAZA TO DESIGN, MANUFACTURE AND INSTALL NEW AND REPLACEMENT WAYFINDING SIGNAGE AT THE CEMETERIES LOCATED WITHIN THE CITY CONSISTENT WITH THE APPROVED BRANDING DESIGN GUIDELINES AND UTILIZING THE APPROVED LOGO FOR AN AMOUNT OF \$23,150; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs ("City") previously approved the design, manufacture and install of a municipal signage program by National Sign Plaza using approved logos and design standards pursuant to Resolution 2019-042;

WHEREAS, the City desires to add new signage at the cemetery located in the downtown and to replace signage at the two cemeteries located on Old Austell Road and requested NSP for a proposal to include these additional signs as part of its existing wayfinding signage agreement;

WHEREAS, the City desires to accept and approve the proposal submitted by National Sign Plaza in the amount of \$23,150 to install new and replacement signage at the cemeteries located within the City;

**BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED** by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that the Mayor is authorized to execute an agreement with National Sign Plaza, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. The resolution shall become effective immediately upon approval.
