A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS REQUIRED FOR THE PURCHASE OF FOUR POLICE VEHICLES, RADIOS AND COMPUTERS TO PROPERLY EQUIP THE FOUR VEHICLES, AND REPLACE THE AUTOMATICELECTRONIC DEFIBRILLATORS IN ALL PATROL VEHICLES AND PUBLIC FACILITIES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs allocates funds for public safety under the Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax program, as approved by voters;

WHEREAS, the Police Department previously received Federal Equitable Sharing Program funds resulting from its participation in the federal program;

WHEREAS, The City desires to use SPLOST and ESP funds to purchase and equip two new police vehicles, equip two existing police vehicles, and to service and replace automatic electronic defibrillators ("AEDs") in accordance with a capital program developed by the Finance Director, Police Chief and City Manager;

BE IT THEREFORE RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and approves the State Contract with Allan Vigil Ford to purchase two Ford Fusions for an amount of \$17,665.00 each;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and approves the lowest responsive proposal by Dana Safety Supply to equip two existing Ford Explorers and two new Ford Fusions for an amount of \$15,000.00;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it accepts and approves the proposal by Cardiotronix to replace existing AED's at the end of their useful life at a per unit cost of \$1,295, to annually service the Zoll AED Fleet for a cumulative amount of \$2,839 and the existing fleet at a per unit cost of \$491.46 until replaced;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the Mayor to execute any agreements required to complete the purchase of vehicles, equipment and AEDs, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
