

RESOLUTION 2026 - 063

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN INTERGOVERNMENTAL AGREEMENT WITH COBB COUNTY AND THE SHERIFF'S OFFICE RELATING TO THE HOUSING OF INMATES IN THE COBB COUNTY ADULT DETENTION CENTER; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs (the "City") previously approved an intergovernmental agreement with the City of Smyrna relating to the housing of inmates under Resolution 2023-121; and

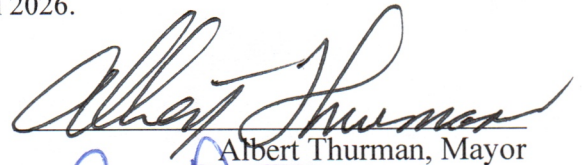
WHEREAS the City has received notice from the City of Smyrna electing to terminate said agreement, and the City desires to execute an intergovernmental agreement with Cobb County for the housing of inmates effective June 1, 2026, which includes the responsibility of the City to cover costs associated with the housing of city prisoners; and

WHEREAS state law allows an extra 10% penalty (County Jail Construction and Staffing Fine Add-on) to be added to fines imposed by the Municipal Court to offset the per diem and medical costs of a city prisoner, and the City desires to approve said 10% surcharge to help offset inmate costs.

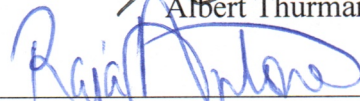
NOW THEREFORE BE RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the Mayor to execute an intergovernmental agreement with Cobb County and the Sheriff's office, in form substantially similar to the attached and subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED THAT an amendment shall be prepared to the code of ordinances to impose the surcharge to help offset inmate costs.

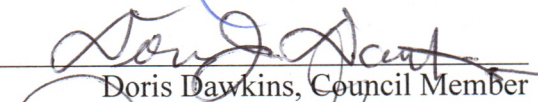
