
**A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH NEWTERRA COMPOST TO PROVIDE WASTE MANAGEMENT AND RECYCLING SERVICES DURING THE BRINGING THE SEA TO THE SPRINGS SEAFOOD FESTIVAL MAY 17, 18 AND 19, 2024 FOR A SUM OF \$4,500; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**


**WHEREAS** the City of Powder Springs (“City”) has received a proposal from NewTerra Compost to provide waste and residual food removal services during the annual seafood festival in a manner that will divert waste from the landfill to provide certain environmental benefits as well as reduce the need for overtime expenses normally incurred by the city in staffing the event for cleanup; and


**WHEREAS** the City finds it in the public interest to engage NewTerra Compost to provide waste management and recycling services to further its strategic priorities of promoting a safe city and creating destinations that appeal to residents and visitors.


**NOW THEREFORE BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with NewTerra Compost to provide waste management and recycling services during the annual Bringing the Sea to the Springs seafood festival on May 17, 18 and 19, 2024, subject to approval by the City Attorney.






