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**AN ORDINANCE TO ADOPT THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEARS 2025-26; TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

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**WHEREAS** a proposed budget prepared for the City of Powder Springs ("City) for Fiscal Year 2025-26 was made available for public review beginning on May 15, 2024 and public hearings were conducted on June 3, 2024 and June 17, 2024 following publication of notice in accordance with OCGA 36-81-5 and 36-81-6; and




**WHEREAS**, the balanced budget has been reviewed by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs (the "City"), and the City has determined that the budget prepared for Fiscal Years 2025-26 is consistent with applicable regulations, laws and policies and it therefore desires to adopt said budget.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs hereby ordain that the budget ordinance for Fiscal Year 2025-26 be adopted as provided in the attached exhibit.


