

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-093

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE USE OF PUBLIC PROPERTY FROM JUNE 27 TO JUNE 29 FROM 7:30 AM TO 9:00 PM FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACCOMMODATING A TEMPORARY OUTREACH EVENT HOSTED BY CALVARY CHRISTIAN MINISTRIES, INC; AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HOPKINS ROAD AND HOPKINS COURT IF DETERMINED NECESSARY BY THE POLICE DEPARTMENT TO MANAGE TRAFFIC CONTROL; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, Calvary Christian Ministries, Inc. did previously apply for a permit to host an outreach event from June 13 to June 16 from 7:30 am to 9:00 pm on property owned by the City of Powder Springs ("City") fronting Hopkins Road across from Hopkins Court, which may require the temporary closure of both roadways for traffic control measures; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to accommodate said event, and the Mayor and Council provided the necessary permission by way of Resolution 2018-063 adopted on May 7, 2018; and

WHEREAS, because of changed circumstances, Calvary Christian Ministries, Inc. has requested a change in the event dates to June 27 through June 29, and the Mayor and Council wish to allow the change.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the use of public property and the temporary road closure or other traffic control measures on Hopkins Road and Hopkins Court from June 27 to June 29 at 7:30 am to 9:00 pm to accommodate a community outreach event hosted by Calvary Christian Ministries. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.




