

RESOLUTION 2019 - 156

A RESOLUTION RESCINDING RESOLUTION 2019-145 THAT APPROVED AND AUTHORIZED THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS REQUIRED FOR THE PURCHASE OF POLICE VEHICLES; AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AGREEMENTS FOR THE PURCHASE OF THREE FORD EXPLORERS FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$102,000; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Police Department previously received Federal Equitable Sharing Program (“ESP”) funds resulting from its participation in the federal program;


WHEREAS, the City previously authorized the purchase of four new 2020 Dodge Chargers from Akins Ford Dodge Jeep Government Sales for an amount of \$99,007 using ESP funds by Resolution 2019-145;


WHEREAS, the police department has been informed that said vehicles will not be available until the 4th quarter of 2020, which negatively impacts operations involving the vehicle take home program and replacing older vehicles;


WHEREAS, the police department has solicited quotes and the City desires to authorize the purchase of three Ford Explorers from Allen Vigil Ford for an amount not to exceed \$102,000;


BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Council for the City of Powder Springs that it rescinds Resolution 2019-145 and hereby directs the Finance Director to prepare the necessary budget amendment to receive and allocate ESP funds for the purchase of three Ford Explorers for an amount not to exceed \$102,000 and authorizes the Mayor to execute any agreements required to complete said purchase, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.
