

RESOLUTION 2021 - 166

A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH PEACHTREE RECOVERY SERVICES, INC FOR THE PURPOSE OF FILING CLAIMS FOR REIMBURSEMENT WITH INSURANCE COMPANIES RELATING TO ACCIDENTS RESULTING IN DAMAGE TO PUBLIC PROPERTY; PROVIDING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.


WHEREAS, Peachtree Recovery Services, Inc. ("PRS") is a partner with the Georgia Municipal Association ("GMA") for the purpose of filing claims for reimbursement with insurance companies relating to accidents resulting in property damage to public property; and


WHEREAS, PRS compares accident and traffic reports sent into the state database and match those reports to municipal boundaries, and if municipal property is involved, it files claims for reimbursement with the insurance companies and retains 19% of the fees collected from the insurance companies as its compensation; and


WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs is eligible as a member of GMA to participate in the recovery program and finds it in the public interest to participate.


NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Mayor and Council for the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the Mayor to execute an agreement with Peachtree Recovery Services, Inc. to file claims for reimbursement with insurance companies relating to accidents in the City resulting in damage to City property, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney. This resolution shall be effective immediately upon adoption.




