A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE A DEDUCTIVE CHANGE ORDER TO THE AGREEMENT WITH BARTOW PAVING RELATING TO THE INTERSECTION IMPROVEMENTS AT RICHARD D SAILORS PARKWAY AND US278; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.
