I am in my 92nd year, and my wife is in her 78th year, and we have problems sleeping. When the church across the road from our house was robbed, they put up higher light poles which shined into our bedroom window. We let the shrubbery grow to about 15 feet high--problem solved.

Now, the David Pearson application plans to put a swimming pool within three feet of our property line and 70 feet from our master bedroom which means that they will have bright lights, loud noises, etc.

I called the AG Financial attorney who is handling the sale of our property on Story Road, and he told us that he was handling this, which meant that we didn't have any say-so.

I called David Pearson several times, but he hasn't returned any of my phone calls. I also called Jim DeVille, David's leg man, and his email is filled and his land line is cancelled. David's plan has 10.45 acres on the back of our property that I recommended that he put the pool there, put a nature trail around the open space like Horton had on their proposal, put a berm around the detention ponds with small pipes to slowly drain excess water.

The "bottoms" is fertile land and has never flood in the 85 years that my family has owned this property, then garden plots could be allocated to each lot for community enhancement.

We submitted a complaint and suggestions previously, and we want to make sure that they will be heard at the 3/16 and 3/21 hearings. COMPLAINT--The plan shows a swimming pool within three feet of our property line and about sixty feet from our master bedroom window; this will cause bright lights and loud noise right outside of our bedroom. We are elderly, 92 and 78 years old, light sleepers, and with the ten acres of green space on the back of the property, it would be better to put the swimming pool there.

SUGGESTIONS: 1. The contractor can put a nature trail around the green space (like Horton Homes proposed). 2. "Bottoms" on both sides of the stream would make good garden plots and be a selling point.
