**AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND THE BUDGET FOR FISCAL YEAR 2021 TO RECEIVE AND ALLOCATE FUNDS FROM THE COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM FOR THE HOPKINS ROAD PEDESTRIAN PARK; TO RECEIVE AND ALLOCATE FUNDS RELATING TO BUILDING PERMIT REVENUES AND EXPENSES; AND TO RECEIVE AND ALLOCATE DOLLARS FOR CAPITAL PROJECTS RELATING TO CAMERON SPRINGS INFRASTRUCTURE IMPROVEMENTS; TO REPEAL CONFLICTING ORDINANCES; TO ESTABLISH AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.**

**WHEREAS**, the City of Powder Springs ("City") desires to amend the Fiscal Year 2021 budget to allocate funds from the Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") program and General Fund for the Hopkins Road pedestrian park improvements project, to receive and allocate funds relating to building permit revenues and expenses, and to receive and allocate dollars for capital projects relating to the Cameron Springs infrastructure improvements;


**NOW THEREFORE**, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs hereby ordain that the budget ordinance for the Fiscal Year 2021 be amended as set forth in the attached Exhibit "A".

**BE IT FURTHER ORDAINED**, that all ordinances and parts of ordinances in conflict herewith hereby repealed, and this ordinance shall become effective immediately upon execution by the Mayor and City Council.






