A RESOLUTION APPROVING AND AUTHORIZING THE USE OF PUBLIC PROPERTY ON SEPTEMBER 26, 2021 FROM 8:00 AM TO 3:00 PM FOR THE PURPOSE OF ACCOMMODATING THE ANNUAL BICYCLE RIDE ACROSS GEORGIA; AUTHORIZING THE TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF HOPKINS AND MACEDONIA ROADS AND THE WILD HORSE TRAIL; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the Bicycle Ride Across Georgia ("BRAG") organization will conduct its annual bicycle ride on September 26, 2021 beginning in Chattanooga, Tennessee and ending in Powder Springs, Georgia;

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it approves and authorizes the use of public property and the temporary road closure or other traffic control measures on Carter, Hopkins and Macedonia Roads and on the Wild Horse Trail on September 26, 2021 from 8:00 am to 3:00 pm to accommodate the annual Bicycle Ride Across Georgia event. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.
