

RESOLUTION NO. 2020 – 104

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT FOR CERTAIN CONTINUED PROFESSIONAL SERVICES RELATED TO INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY, COMMUNICATIONS, EVENTS, DOWNTOWN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT, ANNEXATION AND FINANCIAL SERVICES; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, the City of Powder Springs (the “City”) has a need for continued professional services related to information technology, financial management, event planning, economic development and annexation;

WHEREAS, the City desires to renew professional services with its current providers in accordance with its operating and capital budget;

NOW THEREFORE, be it hereby resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that it authorizes the Mayor to execute agreements for continued professional services for FY21, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney and operating and capital budget amounts for the following: (1) information technology provider VC3 in the amount of \$230,000; (2) financial services provider Camburn in the amount of \$45,000; (3) public information and communication services provider Gargis Consulting in the amount of \$45,000; (4) event professional services provider Sherry Garner in the amount of \$25,000; (5) downtown economic development provider Ann Arnold in the amount of \$30,000; and (6) annexation services with Alliance Strategies in the amount of \$25,000. This resolution shall be effective July 1, 2020.
