

RESOLUTION NO. 2021 - 145

A RESOLUTION APPROVING A TEMPORARY RECREATION EVENT PERMIT FOR THE LINKEDUP CHURCH CONNECT TO HEALTH 5K RUN/WALK IN THE DOWNTOWN; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS, LinkedUp Church has applied for and wishes to conduct a 5K Connect to Health Run/Walk Event on October 2, 2021 from 9:00AM to 1:00PM in Thurman Springs Park, which will entail temporary closures of public roads and trails in the downtown area between 7:30AM and 9:30AM; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs find the application of LinkedUp Church to meet the necessary criteria and wish to grant the requested permit, provided that the Church secure police officers to conduct traffic control and complete all event location cleanup.


NOW THEREFORE, BE IT HEREBY RESOLVED by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the application of LinkedUp Church to conduct a Connect to Health 5K Run/Walk Event in the downtown on October 2, 2021, requiring closure of roads and trails between 7:30AM and 9:30AM, is hereby approved on the condition that the applicant secure police officers to conduct traffic control and complete all event space cleanup. This resolution shall become effective immediately upon adoption.






