A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AND APPROVING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH COMCAST BUSINESS TO PROVIDE INTERNET FIBER SERVICES AT THE NEW MUNICIPAL COMPLEX AND POLICE DEPARTMENT WITH REDUNDANCY FOR ALL CITY FACILITIES; TO EXECUTE WORK ORDERS WITH VC3 TO COMPLETE WORK REQUIRED TO ACHIEVE INSTALLATION AND REDUNDANCY; ESTABLISHING AN EFFECTIVE DATE; AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

WHEREAS the City of Powder Springs (the "City") previously removed fiber and approved installation of stand-alone internet access at city facilities when city offices and services were relocated in order to complete the construction of the new municipal complex; and

WHEREAS in anticipation of project completion and given the immediate need for redundancy at city facilities when internet is interrupted, in particular at the Police Department, the City's IT Consultant, VC3, and IT staff worked with Comcast Business to develop a plan to provide fiber services at the new municipal complex and Police Department with redundancy for all city facilities; and

WHEREAS the payment for fiber at the new municipal complex will be delayed until occupancy but the fiber and redundancy at the Police Department and other city facilities will begin immediately, and the City desires to authorize the fiber install and redundancy as well as work required to be performed by VC3.

NOW THEREFORE, be it resolved by the Mayor and Council of the City of Powder Springs that the mayor is authorized to execute an agreement with Comcast Business to install fiber services at the new municipal complex and police department with redundancy at all city facilities, subject to review and approval by the City Attorney.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor is authorized to execute work orders with VC3 to complete work required to achieve the installation and redundancy.
